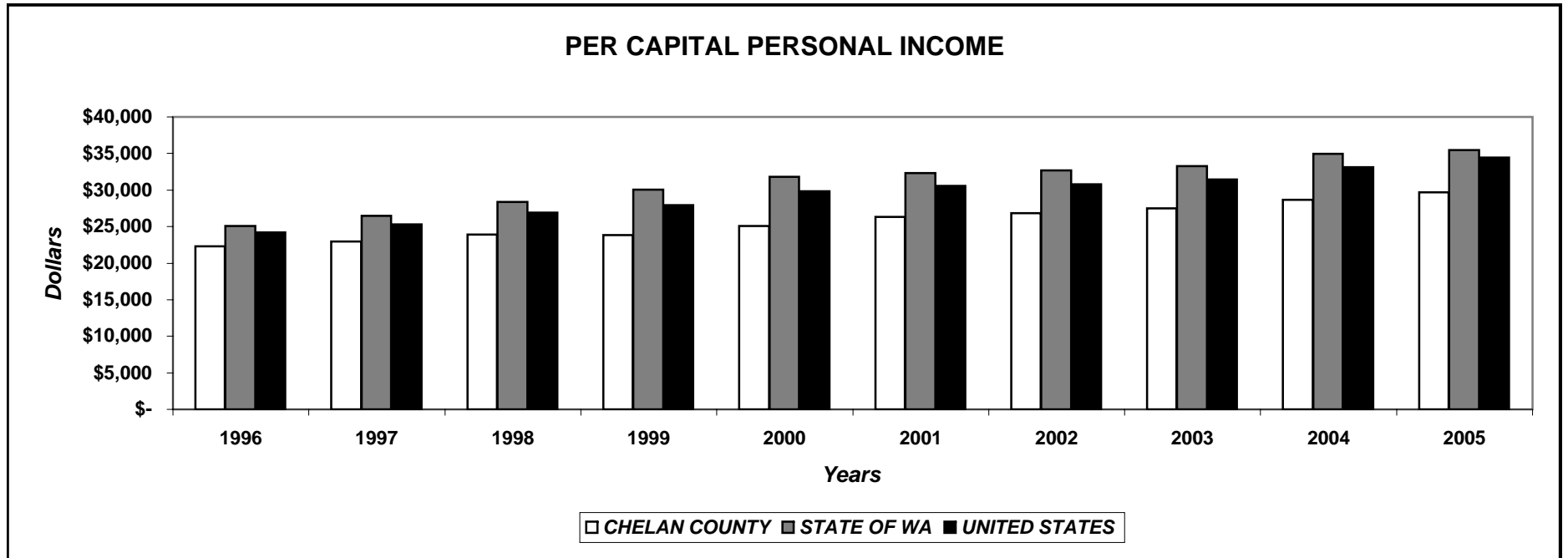

In 2005 Chelan County had a per capita personal income (PCPI) of \$29,657. This PCPI ranked 12th in the state and was 84% of the state average of \$35,479 and 86% of the national average of \$34,471. The 2005 PCPI reflected an increase of 3.4% from 2004. The 2004-2005 state change was 1.5% and the national change was 4.2%. In 1995 the PCPI of Chelan County was \$21,145 and ranked 13th in the state. The 1995-2005 the average annual growth rate of PCPI was 3.4%. The average annual growth rate for the state was 4.1% and for the nation was 4.1%.
