The American Rescue Plan Act of 2021, signed into law by the President on March 11, 2021, includes \$8 billion in funds to be awarded as economic assistance to eligible U.S. airports. The FAA has issued to the public calculations of Airport Rescue Grant Allocations. Pangborn Memorial Airport is scheduled to receive \$1,318,485 toward operations and \$55,359 for Concession Relief. In preparation for the grant offers, we are requesting authorization for the CEO to sign applications and contracts related to these grants upon receipt from the FAA.

Sinclair Systems International, LLC became a tenant of the Port of Chelan County in 2006, upon completion of construction of OSBP Building #9. They currently have a lease for 15,000 square feet of the building, paying \$10,679.37 in monthly base rent (\$0.712 per square foot) which expires August 31, 2021. In comparison, Frito Lay leases the other half of the building at \$0.85 per square foot for a two-year term, and the Chelan County PUD leases Building #5 at \$0.65 per square foot, negotiated as part of a larger land transaction.

We are proposing to present Sinclair with a five year lease renewal, which consists of 3.5% CPI increases on an annual basis, as follows:

September 1, 2021	\$0.73
September 1, 2022	\$0.76
September 1, 2023	\$0.79
September 1, 2024	\$0.82
September 1, 2025	\$0.85

Sinclair has been a good tenant, with timely payments, and we would like to continue our positive relationship moving forward. We are looking for board input on the lease prior to presentation to the tenant, as this lease will exceed the Chief Executive Officer's Delegation of Authority.

PORT OF DOUGLAS COUNTY RESOLUTION NO. 2021-01

A RESOLUTION OF THE BOARD OF COMMISSIONERS OF THE PORT OF DOUGLAS COUNTY TO INCLUDE CERTAIN REAL PROPERTY IN DOUGLAS COUNTY, COMMONLY KNOWN AS THE FIBRO PROPERTY, AS PART OF THE PORT OF DOUGLAS COUNTY'S COMPREHENSIVE SCHEME OF HARBOR IMPROVEMENTS.

Whereas pursuant to Revised Code of Washington, Chapter 53.20, the Port of Douglas County ("PODC") is required to adopt a comprehensive scheme of harbor improvements ("Comprehensive Plan") and amend the plan as may be appropriate prior to undertaking improvement projects; and

Whereas state law provides no specific requirements or guidance to port authorities as to the format, length, or content of a port's Comprehensive plan; however, port authorities have interpreted the law as requiring an inventory and description of all port properties and identification of anticipated future improvements at these properties; and

Whereas the PODC owns real property located in Douglas County, Washington, and legally described on Exhibit "A", which is attached hereto and incorporated herein by this reference (the "Property"); and

Whereas the PODC scheduled a public hearing for June 22, 2021, to consider and evaluate whether the Property should be included and part of the Port's Comprehensive Plan; and

Whereas a staff report was prepared and presented at the hearing and is incorporated as part of the record of the hearing; and

Whereas proper notice of the public hearing was published and an opportunity for public testimony was provided at the public hearing; and

Whereas the Board of Directors of the Chelan Douglas Regional Port Authority, as the manager of the Property, support and approve the decision to include the Property in the PODC's Comprehensive Plan; and

Whereas, following the closure of the hearing, the PODC Commissioners discussed and concluded that the Property should be incorporated into the PODC's portfolio of real property for future planning, evaluation, development, leasing and related opportunities, subject to the PODC's Comprehensive Plan.

Now, Therefore, the Board of Commissioners of the Port of Douglas County hereby resolve as follows:

1. The Property should be incorporated into the PODC's portfolio of real property for future planning, evaluation, development, leasing and related opportunities, as determined by the PODC Commissioners.

2. The PODC's Comprehensive Plan is hereby amended to include the Property.

3. Nothing herein precludes the PODC Commissioners from considering, at a future public hearing, whether to surplus all or a portion of the Property and to remove the Property from the PODC's Comprehensive Plan.

PORT OF CHELAN COUNTY RESOLUTION NO. 2021-02 PORT OF DOUGLAS COUNTY RESOLUTION NO. 2021-04 CHELAN DOUGLAS REGIONAL PORT AUTHORITY RESOLUTION NO. 2021-14

A JOINT RESOLUTION OF THE PORT OF CHELAN COUNTY ("POCC"), THE PORT OF DOUGLAS COUNTY ("PODC"), AND THE CHELAN DOUGLAS REGIONAL PORT AUTHORITY ("CDRPA") REGARDING ADMINISTRATION OF THE COMPREHENSIVE PLANS FOR THE POCC AND THE PODC AND AMENDING POCC RESOLUTION NO. 2019-23, PODC RESOLUTION NO. 2019-16, and CDRPA RESOLUTION NO. 2019-24

Whereas the POCC and the PODC (the "Ports") entered into an Interlocal Agreement for the functional consolidation of the Ports, including finances, management and operations, dated June 11, 2019 (the "2019 ILA");

Whereas in furtherance of the 2019 ILA, the Ports formed the CDRPA on June 30, 2019, setting a functional consolidation date effective January 1, 2020;

Whereas the POCC adopted a Comprehensive Scheme of Harbor Improvements on November 17, 2017 ("POCC Comp Plan");

Whereas the PODC adopted a Comprehensive Scheme of Harbor Improvements on December 22, 2015 ("PODC Comp Plan"). Collectively, the POCC Comp Plan and the PODC Comp Plan shall be referred to as the "Plans" and individually, a "Plan";

Whereas the CDRPA administers the Plans pursuant to CDRPA Joint Resolution No. 2019-24;

Whereas pursuant to the 2019 ILA specific authority is specifically reserved to the respective Ports, including the decision to declare real property as surplus to the needs of the POCC or the PODC;

Whereas consistent with the 2019 ILA, the POCC will be responsible for amendments to the POCC Comp Plan and the PODC will be responsible for amendments to the PODC Comp Plan;

Whereas the CDRPA adopted a policy regarding capital improvements on November 12, 2019;

Whereas the CDRPA, POCC, and PODC adopted a joint resolution on February 11, 2020 regarding the management of property owned by the three entities; and

Whereas Pangborn Memorial Airport is governed by the most recently approved Airport Master Plan, which is incorporated into the Plans.

Now, therefore, the Commissioners for the POCC and the PODC, and Board of Directors of the CDRPA hereby resolve as follows:

- 1. The decision to purchase any property shall be made by the CDRPA. How the property is titled shall be made by the CDRPA at the time of acquisition.
- 2. All property acquired by the CDRPA in furtherance of the Plans or the Airport Master Plan shall automatically be deemed incorporated into the respective Plans as follows:
 - A. Property acquired in Chelan County (whether titled in the POCC or the CDRPA) shall be incorporated into and governed by the POCC Plan, as amended from time to time.
 - B. Except as set forth in subparagraph C, below, property acquired in Douglas County (whether titled in the PODC or the CDRPA) shall be incorporated into and governed by the PODC Plan, as amended from time to time.
 - C. Property acquired in furtherance of Pangborn Memorial Airport shall be titled in the CDRPA and incorporated into and governed by the Airport Master Plan, as amended from time to time.
- 3. Before any real property unrelated to Pangborn Memorial Airport is sold, the property must first be declared surplus by the appropriate Port as set forth in CDRPA Joint Resolution No. 2019-24 to remove the property from the applicable Plan.
- 4. Before any real property associated with Pangborn Memorial Airport is sold, the property must first be declared surplus by both Ports.
- 5. Once the property has been declared surplus as set forth above, then any decision to sell the surplus real property shall be authorized by the CDRPA in a public meeting. The authorization shall be binding on the POCC, PODC and CDRPA and the transaction documents shall reflect the entity who has title to the surplus property.

6. CDRPA Joint Resolution No. 2019-24 is hereby amended for consistency with this Resolution. In the event of a conflict with CDRPA Joint Resolution 2019-24, the terms and conditions of this Resolution shall control.
