






ALASKA'S NORTHWEST CUTS



YEAR ENDED FIRST QUARTER 2006 – YEAR ENDED FIRST QUARTER 2023







YEAR ENDED FIRST QUARTER 2006 – YEAR ENDED FIRST QUARTER 2023










WENATCHEE WAS #2 FOR ALASKA

YEAR ENDED FIRST QUARTER 2022







FIRST QUARTER 2023










MOST DRIVE TO OTHER AIRPORTS









2026: HALF OF RJ FLEET PARKED



















HIGHER FARES REQUIRED

JUNE 2021 VS. AUGUST 2023


